repeatedly collecting sputum from individuals who already tested positive, in order to earn more incentives. Patients sold their free supply of Medicines to have money for other needs, including their vices. Most persons I worked with were honest but a few 'rotten apples' can contaminate the whole 'basket'. Poverty can also make people do things they don't usually do.Sonow,resistantTBhastobecuredbya4 drugregimen.

Rotary, with its fine organization can make a difference in the battle against the above mentioned lung infections. Polio is close to being eradicated, thanks largely to the efforts of R.I. In our area, the Leprosy project during PP Bob Kaiser's term, has virtually eradicated Leprosy from our area. Mycobacterium Leprae whichcausesLeprosy, is closely related to Mycobacterium Tuberculosis which causes T.B. TheDOHisdoingwhatitcanbutitneedshelp. This is the way it is in the 'Anti -Polio' and 'Vitamin A' Campaigns, with Government teamingup with Rotary to attack disease at different levels. I think PDG Ces Mendoza's idea of getting a 'Grant' for Primary Pulmonary Tuberculosis, the initial lung TB infection affecting kids, is good. This group has largely been ignored by the DOH because TB is supposedly not infective at this stage. The expensive 6 monthtripledrugregimenhastobeshouldered by the family of the child, so the kid is not treated at all. Dr. Jose P. Rizal, our National Hero, said that our youth is the hope of the Motherland. Well, if this 'hope' is tubercular and can't breathe, you know where our Motherlandisheaded.

ware that uses <u>computer networks</u> and security holes to replicate itself. A copy of the wormscans the network for another machine that has a specific security hole. It copies itself to the new machine using the security hole, and then starts replicating from there, as well.

◆ **Trojan horses** - A Trojan horse is simply a computerprogram. The program claims to do one thing (it may claim to be a game) but instead does damage when your unit (it may erase your <u>hard disk</u>). Trojan horses have no way to replicate automatically.

#### HowTheySpread

Earlyviruseswerepiecesofcodeattachedto a common program like a popular game or a popular word processor. A person might download an infected game from a bulletin board and run it. A virus like this is a small piece of code embedded in a larger, legitimate program. Any virus is designed to run first when the legitimate program gets executed The virus loads itself into memory and looks around to see if it can find any other programs on the disk. If it can find one, it modifies it to add the virus's code to the unsuspecting program. Then the virus launches the "real program."Theuserreallyhasnowaytoknowthat the virus ever ran. Unfortunately, the virus has now reproduced itself, so two programs are infected. Thenext time either of those programs gets executed, they infect other programs, and thecyclecontinues.

If one of the infected programs is given to another person on a <u>floppy disk</u>, or if it is uploaded to a bulletin board, then other programs getinfected. This is how the virus spreads.

#### AIR-BORNE LUNG INFECTIONS

I guess the observance of lung month would not be complete without a brief discussion of air -borne lung infections. So here it goes. Infectious agents, whether viruses, bacte-

ria, rickettsiae, fungior protozoa, have to enter the human body and overcome its defenses before disease sets in. This can be done through infected bodyfluidstransmitted to another person's bloodstream via transfusion or needle puncture or through disruption of a person's mucosal membranes during sexual intercourse. This is how the virus causing AIDS entersour system. A different route is through the bite of infected animals, like mosquitoes, which transmit the Dengue virus, or the dog which transmits the Rabies virus. Then there is ingestion of contaminated food and drink like what occurs with the Salmonellabacteria which causes typhoid.Lastly,thereisairborneinfection.This modeoftransmission, unlike the others is difficulttopreventunlessoneispreparedtopermanently wear a mask covering one's nose and mouth. Luckily, the common lung infections, like pneumonia and pulmonary tuberculosis, have effective treatment regimens. The tragedy is that despite available treatment, these diseases still rank high in the developing world as causes of illness and death. This is due to povertywithlackofnutritiontobuilddiseaseresistance, poorhousing facilities with lack of ventilation and overcrowding, ignorance and of course, inability to buy the needed medicines. Pneumonia results from inflammation of lungtissue filling our air sacs with fluid and so we drown in our own secretions. It tends to

affect the very young sector of our society. Recent statistic sinour country show that 60 out ofevery1000kidsbelow5yearshavepneumonia and that of these, 5 out of 11000 will die. An experience which stuck to my mind during my Medical Clerkship, was that of a cuddly child who was brought to the UST E.R. because of rapidbreathing.Asclerk,Iimmediatelyelicited a history of recent Measles infection and noted severalskinlesionsinthechild'sarmsandlegs. After an oxygen mask was placed on the child and before an X -ray to confirm pneumonia could be done, the child stopped breathing. The haplessmomwhowasonlyhalf -awarethather childwasseriouslyill, washysterical with grief and guilt while a futile resuscitation was being undertaken. This spectacle is still being repeated countless times in the developing world. The sadthing is that Measles, Mumps, Chicken PoxandInfluenzaw/cmakekidssusceptibleto bacterial pneumonia, can be prevented by vaccination. Even after the pneumonia has set in, the prompt use of appropriate antibiotics would curethechild.

Then we have Pulmonary Tuberculosis w/c even today kills 75 Filipinos daily. Lung TB also has a way of causing debilitation of active bread-winning family members turning them into dependents. This is sad because we could have eradicated TB several years ago. During my short stint as a Rural Health physician in Santol, La Union, I became witness to loopholes of our government's public health programs. Midwives who were collecting sputum specimenfrommembersofeachbarangaywere given incentives for every sputum specimen that tested positive for TB. The individual who tested positive was given free medicines for 6 months of a double -drug regimen, which was then adequate. Alas, some midwives took to



Computer viruses are mysterious and grab ourattention.Ontheonehand, viruses showus how vulnerable we are. A properly engineered virus can have an amazing effect on the worldwide Internet. On the other hand, they show how sophisticated and interconnected human beings have become. For example, the Melissa virus -- which became a global phenomenon in March 1999 -- was so powerful that it forced Microsoft and a number of other very large companies to completely turn off their e-mail systems until the virus could be contained. The ILOVEYOUvirus in2000hadasimilarlydevastating effect. That's pretty impressive when you consider that the Melissa and ILOVEYOU virusesareincrediblysimple.

#### **TypesofInfection**

When youlisten to the news, you hear about many different forms of electronic infection. • Viruses - Avirusisa small piece of software that piggybacks on real programs. For example,avirusmight attach itself to a programsuchasaspreadsheet program. Each time the spreadsheet program runs, the vi-

rus runs, too, and it has the chance to reproduce (by attaching to other programs) or wreakhavoc.

• E-mail viruses - An e -mail virus moves aroundin e-mailmessages, and usually replicates itself by automatically mailing itself to dozens of people in the victim's e -mail addressbook.
